

RESOLUTION 18-02

RESOLUTION REQUESTING ADMITTANCE TO THE  
WEST-CENTRAL MEADE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the ambulance service which provided first responder, ambulance services to the Town of Buffalo Chip, South Dakota, is no longer able to extend such services to the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Meade County Commission is currently in the process of establishing a new ambulance district, which, if so desired by the Town Board, would include the area inside the municipal boundaries of the Town of Buffalo Chip, South Dakota; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that it is in the best interests and promotion of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of the Town to be included in the ambulance district to provide first responder services inside the Town of Buffalo Chip.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to SDCL 34-11A-2, the Town of Buffalo Chip, South Dakota, a South Dakota municipal corporation, does hereby formally request admittance into the West-Central Meade County Ambulance District and to be availed with all rights, services and obligations associated therewith. The territory shall include all real property inside the current municipal boundaries of the Town of Buffalo Chip, South Dakota, and any future expansion thereof.
